Children & Youth

Children and youth are a priority for TCC as evidenced by the launch of our children and youth ministry that includes the following:

- The children and youth program is evaluated, redesigned, and implemented
- A full-time experienced children and youth leader is hired. Internships continue.
- Everyone at TCC is involved in discipling our children and youth.
- Financial needs for the program are integrated in the budget.
- Formal and informal mentoring relationships are nurtured.
- Profession of Faith is cherished and celebrated as an important milestone in the faith process.
- Children and youth are involved in church leadership, teams and activities, and given increasing responsibilities in the development of their skills.
- Service events are designed to engage with each other and reach outward in service.

Community Impact

Community impact will be a priority as evidenced by:

- A team is appointed with the purpose of identifying specific service opportunities with a focus on reaching out to people who are helpless, homeless, economically challenged, or otherwise in need.
- Using the building and land, we will serve the community. We will explore significant infrastructure and program improvements that allow us to minister in new ways.
- Being actively involved in growing the church locally, regionally, nationally and internationally through prayer, time, physical efforts, and giving.
- Extending an open door to other organizations and people in the community as TCC has modeled in our relationships with Whitney House, we grow in our acceptance, inclusion, and involvement with people of all ages and abilities.
