Where:

CranHill in Rodney, MI (1.25 hours from Grand Rapids)

When:

June 16-21, 2024

Who:

Open to all ages! Students in middle school or younger will require a parent/adult to attend with them.

Why:

Our youth mission trip cycle offers an every four-year rotation of a local/intergenerational mission trip to include the rest of the congregation. We are combining our commitment to children, youth, and all abilities into one wonderful summer trip!

How:

Firm commitments to attend are needed by December 1, 2023. A 50% deposit will be taken at this time to hold your spot.

Accommodations:

We are renting out several on-campus housing options. You will stay in either a cottage, or you can bring your own camper/tent and stay in the campground. If housing is a concern for you, please reach out so we can best accommodate your needs.

Cost:

\$100/person for the whole week or \$20/day for those participating partially.

Payment helps cover housing rentals, meals and material costs.

The Work:

- 1. High-school youth and other adult leaders interested will volunteer with Friendship Camp by participating in camp activities and building relationships.
- 2. Adults, middle school youth and children can participate in two other ways:
 - a. Serving on kitchen, housekeeping or maintenance staff
 - b. Assisting with special projects (construction, clean-up, etc)

Full or partial week options are available.

Additional Option for Kids: Send your kids to day-camp or overnight camp! Work during the day while your kids get to play.
